Benefits of Membership

- The Tasmanian Pagan Alliance produces a quarterly newsletter, The Ravens' Call, sent out to all members every season. In every issue of the Ravens' Call, you will find event and moot reports, book reviews, feature stories of pagan interest, regular articles, and the opportunity to be part of this statewide team effort.



- Invitations to area and state events (Sabbats, Celebrations, Awards Day, and the Annual General Meeting). Regular events are held annually, participation is encouraged and help with organising these events is appreciated.



- Monthlyly Moots, meetings of Pagans in the Pub are held in areas across the State, where forum topics are discussed and guest speakers may give talks and demonstrations.

Membership Fees

Annual membership commences on the 1st of July. We have three membership options:
Single Membership \$25

Joint Membership (2 adults) \$35

Family Membership (2 adults + up to 2 u/18 children) \$55
If you join in June, only 20% of the year needs to be paid (\$5, &7 and \$11 respectively) to bring you in line with everyone else.



The Pagan Ethic

- Each individual is responsible for discovering and developing their own true nature in harmony with the greater world, and takes full responsibility for their actions.
- Acknowledge that the actual beliefs of every Pagan are a personal choice and the rights of every person to worship and honour the god(s) and/or goddess(es) that provide them with a connection to the divine.
- Reverence for the life force and its ever-renewing cycles of life and death. That all things of nature and the universe, all animals including man, all plants and all conceivable physical matter are part of the divine and worthy of respect.
- Acceptance of the many-faceted nature of divinity, that divinity exists in many forms, and can be worshipped and respected as male, female, androgynous, or in a form beyond human definition.
- Respect all Pagans' right to freedom of choice, safety, privacy and differing opinions.
- Take care, in personal behaviour, to consider the feelings and comfort of others.
